God's Promises about Jesus

Jesus is Your

Savior:

- We have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be the Savior of the World.

1 John 4:14

-All who call on the name of the Lord will be saved. Romans 10:13

Source of Your Love and Ultimate Expression of God's Love:

-God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

-And this is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. 1 John 4:10

Basis of Peace:

(Jesus) was delivered over to death for our sins, and was raised to life for our justification. Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 4:25, 5:1

Righteousness:

-God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God. 2 Corinthians 5:21

-I want to gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes through the law, but that which is through faith in Christ---the righteousness that comes from God and is by faith. Philippians 3:9

Deliverer:

If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth and the truth will set you free. If the Son sets you free, you are free indeed. John 8:32,35

Brother:

-To all who received him (Jesus), to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God. John 1:12

-For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, are sons of God. Romans 8:14

Justifier:

-Therefore no one will be declared righteous in (God's) sight by observing the law; rather through the law we become conscious of sin. But now a righteousness from God, apart from law, has been made known to which the law and prophets testify. This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. Romans 3:20-24

-But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God. 1 Corinthians 6:11

-Jesus was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification. Romans 4:25

-We know that a man is not justified by observing the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ. Galatians 2:16

Hope and Security:

-Blessed be God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade—kept in heaven for you who through faith are shielded by God's power until the day of salvation. 1 Peter 1:3-5

Source of Contentment:

I have learned the secret of being content whatever the circumstances. I know what is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do everything through him who gives me strength....My God will supply all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:10-13, 19

Source of Eternal Life:

-I am the Resurrection and the life, whoever believes in me, though they should die, yet they shall live. And whoever believes in me will never die. John 11:25-26

-I am the way, the truth and the life, no one comes to the Father except through me. John 14:6

What the Bible has to say about:

Faith:

- Faith is being sure of what we hope for, and certain of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1
- The just shall live by faith. Romans 1:17
- Without faith it impossible to please God. Hebrews 11:7

Hope:

- To them (the gentiles) God has chosen to make know the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Colossians 1:27

Eternal Life:

- And this is our testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. 1 John 5:11
- Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life: he that believes in me, though he is dead, yet shall live. And whoever lives and believes in me shall never die. John 11:25-26

Forgiveness:

- If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just to forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness 1 John 1:9
- As far as the east is from the west, so far as he removed our sins from us. Psalm 103:2

Discipleship:

- Let your light shine before men that they might see your good works and glorify your heavenly Father. Matthew 15:16
- Train up a child in the way he should go; and when he is old, he will not depart from it. Proverbs 22:6
