Life Thoughts Via Lutherans For Life...

Easter II – How remarkable that our Lord's beloved Apostle St. John describes the Gospel of Jesus Christ as "the Word of Life" (1 John 1:2). He also declares all believers qualify as "little children" (2:1). And he proclaims that God has given His Son to redeem "the whole world" – every member of the human race, no matter what age, appearance, or ability. Even personal choice or political controversy can't keep us quiet about it!



The Merger Consideration Committee has decided that in order to make this determination, we need to hear from members of all three congregations. We feel this is best accomplished by worshipping jointly and coming together for fellowship afterwards. We will meet jointly for three consecutive weeks, once at each site, with St. John's hosting the first week, Trinity the next, and Messiah for the final week. **Only one worship service will be offered at one location for that particular Sunday.** The other two congregation locations will not have worship services or fellowship for that particular Sunday. All three congregations' memberships are strongly encouraged to attend worship and fellowship together. And Sunday School will be offered all three weeks during fellowship time. We are inviting you to participate each week.

✠ **Sunday, April 14 at 9:00 a.m. only. Joint worship at St. John's, 1000 Bluff St.** with joint fellowship discussion following worship.
Worship Theme: Seeking God's Wisdom in Reconciliation. How to resolve conflict to leave the past in the past.

✠ **Sunday, April 21 at 9:00 a.m. only (not 9:30 a.m.) Joint worship at Trinity, 1850 Cranston Rd** with joint fellowship discussion following worship.
Worship Theme: Seeking God's Wisdom in Unity. How to express our Lutheran Confession of Faith in fellowship with each other.

✠ **Sunday, April 28 at 9:00 a.m. only (no 11:00 a.m. service). Joint worship at Messiah, 1531 Townline Avenue,** with joint fellowship discussion following worship.
