The congregation has an opening for a part-time Church Office Manager/Secretary due to the pending departure of the incumbent. The position serves as Office Manager for the congregation and provides secretarial support to the Pastor and various officers and board members. Managing the office and handling light administrative tasks are required.

Qualifications include office management and computer competency including the use of Office, particularly Word, Excel, Publisher, and Outlook. The congregation also uses some proprietary software, which must be learned during the transition process. Educational attainment for various clerical and secretarial skill sets is also required.

Work hours are flexible but some regular office hours are maintained as a service to the congregation. Remote work is also possible, when appropriate. Starting salary will be between \$20 and \$24 per hour depending upon qualifications and experience.
