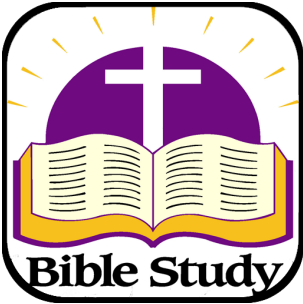
A Most Hearty Welcome To Everyone Today!

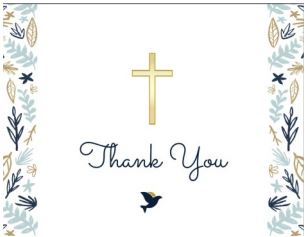
